## **ALEXIS BRISKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

The Board of Directors of the Los Gatos-Cupertino-Saratoga Girls Softball Association awards a scholarship each year to one or more graduating seniors from high school who were players in LGCS Fastpitch Softball in honor of the late Alexis Briski. Recipients of this Memorial Scholarship are selected in recognition of their exemplifying the qualities that Alexis displayed during her short lifetime — a love of softball, a competitive spirit and a never-give-up attitude both on the field and in the classroom. One or more scholarships in an amount up to \$1,500 are awarded each year.

In order to be eligible for the scholarship, a student should have played in the LGCS softball program and must be a member of the graduating class of 2024.

Students interested in applying for the scholarships must submit the following materials:

- A completed LGCS Alexis Briski Memorial Scholarship form
- A high school transcript
- An essay of approximately 250 words describing her experiences in school, life and softball and how those experiences have influenced her future goals and life plans.
